<sup>1</sup> The Action Range is the only place on our grounds where firearms can be drawn from a holster. The Action range includes turning targets and shooting at steel targets. The fee is a one-time charge and does not require annual renewal. Before being given the access code for the Action Range, members must demonstrate that they can safely draw their firearm from a holster, and safely put it back in the holster.
